

*** Risk of Falling Trees ***

Do you ever camp under trees? Have you ever had a tree or a tree limb fall near your camp?

Trees and limbs may fall unpredictably. Being under or near trees may be dangerous and could cause injury.

Be aware that it may be dangerous to set up camp, park your car and picnic under trees as limbs can swing out beyond the edge of the canopy of a tree.

There are risks involved in being outdoors, one risk is trees falling or dropping limbs.

Gums trees are particularly prone to dropping large branches at

any time without warning.

This is why the safest place for all visitors to enjoy a rest, camp with a motorhome or caravan, park their car or have a picnic is in a clear area AWAY from large trees.

However, the risk of falling limbs applies not only to Gum Trees, so be sure to stay well clear of **ALL** trees regardless of their type.

Be safe, not sorry

As there is no way to predict exactly when a tree might fall or drop a limb it is **ALWAYS** better to be safe than sorry.
